

# 2024 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT



## Poland Spring Road (Route 122) Bridge, Auburn



### Project Highlights

- \$4.7 million project
- Awarded to CPM Constructors of Freeport, ME
- Work includes concrete deck and steel girder replacement
- Bridge to be closed during construction
- Closure scheduled to begin on Monday, April 15th
- Detour route will be signed during closure
- Bridge anticipated to reopen in November 2024

This project includes repairs to the Poland Spring Road Bridge that crosses over the Maine Turnpike at Mile 74.0 in the City of Auburn.

The bridge work includes concrete deck and steel girder replacement as well as concrete substructure repairs, approach work, paving, and guardrail and bridge rails replacement.

During the construction, CPM will need to close the bridge for approximately six months.

The closure is scheduled to begin on Monday, April 15, 2024. During the closure a detour route will be signed.

## Poland Spring Road (Route 122) Detour Route



Approximately 3,475 vehicles travel over the mainline of the Maine Turnpike on Poland Spring Road daily. The bridge will be closed during construction and local traffic will be routed around the site via a detour using Hotel Road, Kittyhawk Avenue, and Washington Street (Route 202). The detour as signed is approximately 3.25 miles long.
