Project Highlights

- \$677,000 project
- Awarded to Sargent Corporation from Stillwater, ME
- Construction of new northbound and southbound EVRs
- Clearing to begin week of September 18th
- Ramp construction anticipated to occur in Oct. & Nov.
- Project anticipated to be complete by mid-November 2023

This project includes the construction of new Emergency Vehicle Ramps (EVR) at the High Street Underpass Bridge in West Gardiner.

Since the early 2000's, MTA has been constructing EVRs at various locations as part of a Turnpike-wide safety initiative along the highway. These EVRs improve safety for travelers and MTA workers by utilizing special purpose ramps that allow plow trucks and other emergency vehicles to reverse direction on the Turnpike instead of making difficult U-Turns using center median openings.

The work is anticipated to begin in mid-September and will be completed this fall in time for use during the winter plowing season.
