He held various roles including patrolling the Turnpike at night ensuring the safety of patrons through the harsh, cold winter months. In mid-April of 2007, Mr. Dunlap fell from a ladder when working at the Crosby Maintenance facility and suffered injuries requiring hospitalization.
