BLACKSTRAP ROAD AND MCRR OVERPASSES
MILE 0.4 AND MILE 0.5 ON THE FALMOUTH SPUR

at the office of the Maine Turnpike Authority, 2360 Congress Street, Portland, ME 04102, until 10:00 a.m., prevailing time as determined by the Authority on May 19, 2009 at which time and place the Proposals will be publicly opened and read (please note that the MTA will be relocating from 430 Riverside Street to 2360 Congress Street on May 18, 2009). Bids will be accepted from Contractors **pre-qualified** by the Maine Department of Transportation for Highway and Bridge Construction Projects. All other bids may be rejected. This Project includes a wage determination developed by the State of Maine Department of Labor.

The work consists of removing and replacing the existing bridge deck of the Blackstrap Road Overpass and removing, replacing and widening the existing bridge deck over Maine Central Railroad, both in the Town of Falmouth. The work includes pavement, guardrail, structural concrete, concrete deck and parapets, fabrication and erection of steel beams, concrete substructure modifications and repair, and all other work incidental thereto in accordance with the Plans and Specifications.

The general limits of work are from Mile 0 (Station 0+00) to Mile 3 (Station 150+00) on the Falmouth Spur in Falmouth, Maine.

Plans and Contract Documents may be examined by prospective Bidders weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the office of the Maine Turnpike Authority, 430 Riverside Street, Portland, Maine. The Plans and Contract Documents may be obtained from the Authority upon payment of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each set, which payment will not be returned. Checks shall be made payable to: Maine Turnpike Authority. Plans will be available at 430 Riverside until 4:30 pm on May 14th, 2009; plan purchasing will resume at 8:00 am on May 18th, 2009 at 2360 Congress Street.
