GENERAL

All questions regarding Contract 2018.14 shall be submitted in writing by April 19, 2018 at 12 pm. Questions received after that time may not be answered.

QUESTIONS

The following are questions submitted to the Maine Turnpike Authority in writing. Answers to the questions are noted. Bidders shall utilize this information in preparing their bid.

Question 1: In reference to SP-17, second paragraph, is the additional material referenced (10% contingency) required to be turned over to the Authority? What is this contingency for?

Answer: The contingency is for future repairs of roofing and siding by MTA building maintenance.

Question 2: In reference to SP-43 and SP-54, where existing roof sheathing and wall sheathing is rotted it is to be replaced. If required, how is this paid?

Answer: The contractor shall account for an anticipated small quantity of sheathing replacement (around windows, doors, along roof line edges and penetrations, etc.) with the lump sum item for each building. If unanticipated large quantities of sheathing are rotted, this will constitute a change in condition and an extra work order will be negotiated.

Question 3: Can the Zoo Destratification Fan model H60 be approved for use on this project?

Answer: Yes - Zoo Destratification Fan model H60 is approved for use on this project.

Notes: The above items shall be considered as part of the bid submittal.
