The bid opening date is Thursday, March 14, 2024 at 1:00 p.m.

All questions regarding Contract 2024.05 must be submitted by close of business February 21, 2024.

The following changes are made to the Specifications.

#### **SPECIFICATIONS**

- Special Provision page SP-12: Within Section 104.4.7 delete reference to MTA Contract 2024.51, Bennett Road Underpass Bridge haunch removal. The project has been completed and will not affect this Contract.
- Special Provision page SP-12: Within Section 104.4.7 modify the description of the Gray Water District project to indicate the anticipated completion date of the work is March 11, 2024.
- Special Provision page SP-80: Beneath "Maine Turnpike under the Shaker Road Underpass Bridge Traffic Control Requirements" modify the description of the water line construction project by Gray Water District to indicate the anticipated completion date of the work is March 11, 2024.
- Special Provision page SP-81: Beneath "Maine Turnpike under the Bennett Road Underpass Bridge Traffic Control Requirements" delete the first paragraph referencing the "on-going bridge haunch removal". The project has been completed and will not affect this Contract.
- Appendix D, Temporary Signal Plan is deleted and replaced with the Temporary Signal Plan included in this Addendum. The revision to this plan provides additional construction details of the temporary traffic signal and its phasing and timing.

#### **QUESTIONS**

The following are questions asked and comments made at the pre-bid conference held on February 13, 2024 or submitted to the Maine Turnpike Authority in writing. Answers to the questions are noted. Bidders shall utilize this information in preparing their bid.

- Question 1: At the Shaker Road, Weymouth Road, and Bennett Road underpass bridges temporary lane closures are not permitted in July and August (northbound from 3 PM to 7 PM Monday through Friday and southbound 11 AM to 5 PM on Sunday). Are 24-hour lane closures permissible in other months?

  Answer: No. Temporary lane closures are allowed only when work is underway.
- Question 2: Will the cleaning and painting of the I-295 Southbound Underpass Bridge also address areas of rust visible on the steel?

  Answer: No. This contract will clean and paint only those areas of unpainted or bare steel related to girder splices and cross-frames as well as the areas of failed coatings on the underside of the top flanges of the two new girders. Refer to the description in the Specification and the annotated framing plan and photos in Appendix C. Comprehensive cleaning and painting of the full structure will be undertaken by a future contract.
- Question 3: Is drilling into the existing bridge concrete for the support of work staging permitted?

  Answer: No tapping or drilling into the existing bridge concrete will be allowed. Refer to page SP-24.
- Question 4: Portable concrete barrier will be supplied by the Maine Turnpike Authority. Is it the Contractor's responsibility to install and return the PCB and to install temporary barrier markers?

  Answer: Yes, it is the Contractor's responsibility to load the PCB at the MTA Crosby maintenance facility; transport, set, reset, and remove the PCB; and return, sort, and stack the PCB at the facility. The Contractor shall also furnish and mount retro-reflective PCB delineators. Refer to Specification section 526.01, page SP-41.
- Question 5: Will temporary traffic control require traffic officers?

  Answer: Temporary traffic control on local roads will utilize flaggers. The need for State Police for temporary traffic control operations on the Turnpike will be at the discretion of the Resident. The Authority will make payment for State Police officers and vehicles directly to State Police. Refer to Specification section 652.41, page SP-72.
- Question 6: Does the Contract's two-year warranty requirement for coatings apply to the I-295 Southbound Underpass Bridge where only spot cleaning and painting will be done? Answer: Yes, the two-year warranty requirement applies to all coatings within this Contract.
- Question 7: What is the purpose of item 619.1202 Temporary Mulch and when will it be used?

Answer: Temporary mulch is for temporary or permanent erosion control and for the restoration of roadside areas disturbed by construction activities. Refer to Special Provision Section 619.

Question 8: Page SP-65 mentions "milling and paving of interchange ramps". Is any pavement work anticipated?

Answer: Special Provision Section 652 is meant to be applicable to a variety of Turnpike work, including paving. No pavement work is included in this Contract.

Question 9: Specification section 506.32 requires QC personnel with NACE Level I or II certification, and a QC Supervisor with NACE Level II or III certification. Can these QC positions be filled by Contractor personnel, or is QC by a third party required?

Answer: The certified QC personnel can be Contractor staff. However, air monitoring and soil evaluations must be done by an independent environmental monitoring firm.

Question 10: Are rumble strips required?

Answer: They are not required but rather a contractor traffic control option.

Question 11: How was the area or coatings computed on the I-295 Southbound Underpass Bridge for the work on the underside of the top flanges of the two new girders?

Answer: The area of required cleaning and coating on the underside of the girder top flanges was conservatively computed as a 4" wide strip extending the full length of the girder; however, the Contractor is only required to repair and feather actual areas of damage and may perform this work as spot repairs in lieu of a strip.





  - Splice plates and cross-frame connector plates primer
  - Some bare steel on girder webs
  - 'Disturbed Surfaces' on underside of girder top flange





I-295 Southbound Underpass - Framing Plan excerpt



## <u>Appendix B - Permitted Lane Closure Notes - Turnpike</u>


- Shaker Rd, Weymouth Rd, Bennett Rd
  - NB no lane closures 3-7 PM Mon-Fri (July and August)
  - SB no lane closures 11 AM 5 PM Sunday (July and August)
- I-295 Southbound
  - Temporary lane closure permitted on Turnpike and underpass bridge - no time restrictions
- TMAs, Automated Trailer-Mounted Speed Limit Signs, PCMS - REQUIRED





<u>Appendix D - Temporary Traffic Signals (Weymouth, Bennett)</u>

- Submit TCP to MTA for approval
- Use PCMS for 2-week notice of lane closure







## **General Notes**

- Submit TCP for each bridge site to MTA for approval
  - 2-week notice of start of MOT
- Short-term lane closures on underpass bridges allowed
  - Shaker Rd Underpass Bridge: No lane closures 7-9 AM or 3-5 PM
- Emergency Vehicle Ramps must remain open at all times
- No turning in private roads or driveways

• **Item 659.10** covers all contractor equipment, access, and storage for all work locations.





## 19 - SPECIFIC CONTRACT ITEMS

- Item 506 Coatings: individual pay items are provided for painting, surface prep, containment system, and waste disposal for each of the four bridge sites
- Item 652 Maintenance of Traffic: individual lump-sum pay item is provided for each bridge site
  - Includes all items for MOT above and below underpass bridge
  - Temporary signals, TMAs, PCMS, flaggers, signs, etc.




