- Remove AP-A4 and Replace with the attached AP-A4 REVISED.

PLANS:

- Addendum #1 reissued plan sheets 32 and 33. Remove bid plan sheets 32 and 33 and Replace with the attached plan sheets 32 and 33 that were part of Addendum #1.

The following are questions submitted to the Maine Turnpike Authority in writing. Answers to the questions are noted. Bidders shall utilize this information in preparing their bid.

Question 1: How far into the ramps will the milling and paving extend?

Answer 1: They extend in to the existing match lines.

Question 2: Is hot rubber joint seal required on shim?

Answer 2: No.

Question 3: What class of concrete is required for the concrete collars?

Answer 3: Class B.

Question 4: Will the weepers in the 4' shoulder need to be tapered for traffic to travel over them?

Answer 4: No.

Question 5: Can work on pipe ends and MM 104.9 NB turnout be completed using a shoulder closure?

Answer 5: See General Provisions Section 652 and Special Provisions section 652.

Question 6: Can formwork for the concrete collars be left in place?

Answer 6: No.

Question 7: Will temporary striping and removal of existing striping be required for the temporary detours on Northern Avenue?

Answer 7: No.

Notes: The above items shall be considered as part of the bid submittal.
