at the office of the Maine Turnpike Authority, 2360 Congress Street, Portland, Maine, until 11:00 a.m., prevailing time as determined by the Authority on February 18, 2016 at which time and place the Proposals will be publicly opened and read. Bids will be accepted from Contractors prequalified by the Maine Department of Transportation for Paving Construction Projects. All other bids may be rejected. This Project includes a wage determination developed by the State of Maine Department of Labor.

The pavement rehabilitation work consists of milling and filling the two 12-foot wide lanes and the median shoulder in Locations 1 and 2 from mile 54.5 to mile 57.0. The pavement rehabilitation work also consists of overlaying the two 12-foot wide lanes in Locations 1 and 2 and the shoulders from mile 54.5 to mile 57.0. The pavement rehabilitation work consists of shimming, overlaying, milling and filling the two northbound 12-foot wide lanes and the shoulders in Location 3 from mile 59.5 to mile 64.4. The pavement rehabilitation work consists of shimming, overlaying, milling and filling the two southbound 12-foot wide lanes and the shoulders in Location 4 from mile 64.4 to mile 57.0. The pavement rehabilitation also consists of milling and filling and overlaying the four ramps at Exit 63. The work also involves earthwork, bridge repairs, snow fence installation, drainage, guardrail, pavement markings, maintenance of traffic and all other work incidental thereto in accordance with the Plans and Specifications in Locations 1 through 11.

The General Limits of work are as follows:

Location 1: Northbound travel lanes from Mile 54.5 (Sta. 2726+50) in the Town of Falmouth and extending northerly to Mile 57.0 (Sta. 2850+00) in the Town of Cumberland;

Location 2: Southbound travel lanes from Mile 57.0 (Sta. 2850+00) in the Town of Cumberland and extending southerly to Mile 54.5 (Sta. 2726+50) in the Town of Falmouth.

- Location 3: Northbound travel lanes from Mile 59.5 (Sta. 2982+70) in the Town of Gray and extending northerly to Mile 64.4 (Sta. 3240+50) in the Town of Gray;
- Location 4: Southbound travel lanes from Mile 64.4 (Sta. 3240+50) in the Town of Gray and extending southerly to Mile 57.0 (Sta. 2850+00) in the Town of Cumberland.
- Location 5: Clear zone and drainage work of northbound travel lanes from Mile 54.5 (Sta. 2726+50) in the Town of Falmouth and extending northerly to Mile 64.4 (Sta. 3240+50) in the Town of Gray;
- Location 6: Clear zone and drainage work of southbound travel lanes from Mile 64.4 (Sta. 3240+50) in the Town of Gray and extending southerly to Mile 54.5 (Sta. 2726+50) in the Town of Falmouth.
- Location 7: Eagles Nest Road bridge work at Mile 60.8 (Sta. 3049+20) in the Town of Gray.
- Location 8: Hunts Hill Road bridge work at Mile 61.6 (Sta. 3093+00) in the Town of Gray.
- Location 9: Bennett Road bridge snow fence installation work at Mile 68.6 (Sta. 3459+71.30) in the Town of New Gloucester.
- Location 10: Kittyhawk Avenue bridge snow fence installation work at Mile 75.0 (Sta. 3784+03) in the Town of Auburn.
- Location 11: Northbound and southbound milling and paving and overlaying of the acceleration and deceleration lanes at Exit 63 (Sta. 3168+50.00) in the Town of Gray.

Plans and Contract Documents may be examined by prospective Bidders weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the office of the Maine Turnpike Authority, 2360 Congress Street, Portland, Maine. The Plans and Contract Documents may be obtained from the Authority upon payment of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each set, which payment will not be returned. Bidders shall not contact any other Authority staff or Consultants for clarification of Contract provisions, and the Authority will not be responsible for any interpretations so obtained.

All work shall be governed by the Specifications entitled "State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, Revision of November 2014", price \$13, (\$16 by mail) "Standard Details, Revision of November 2014" and "Best Management Practices for Erosion and Sediment Control", latest issue. Proposals must be accompanied by an original bid bond, certified or cashier's check payable to the Maine Turnpike Authority in an amount not less than Five (5%) Percent of the Total Amount in the Proposal, but not less than \$500.00. The Bidder to whom a Contract is awarded will be required to furnish a Surety Corporation Bond, satisfactory to the Authority, on the standard Contract Bond form of the Authority, for a sum not less than the Total Amount of the Proposal.

Proposals must be made upon the Proposal Forms furnished by the Authority separately with the Contract Documents, and must be enclosed in the sealed special addressed envelope provided therefore bearing the name and address of the Bidder, the name of the Contract, and the date and time of Proposal opening on the outside.

A pre-bid conference will be held on February 4, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. at the Maine Turnpike Authority, 2360 Congress Street, Portland, Maine.

The Authority reserves the unqualified right to reject any or all Proposals and to accept that Proposal which in its sole judgment will under all circumstances serves its best interest.
