

TREE AND BRUSH REMOVAL

In addition to the typical vegetation management activities undertaken every winter, Highway Maintenance crews will be supporting upcoming Capital Improvement Projects scheduled for 2015 this winter by completing tree and brush removal ahead of the construction schedule.



The picture on the left shows Crews selectively cutting trees and brush adjacent to environmentally sensitive areas for the upcoming Roadside Clearing contract. On the right, Crews are clearing trees at the toe of slope for the Toll Plaza upgrades and lane addition at Exit 36.

TRAFFIC CONTROL OPERATIONS
