at the office of the Maine Turnpike Authority, 2360 Congress Street, Portland, ME, until 11:00 a.m., prevailing time as determined by the Authority on June 20, 2017 at which time and place the Proposals will be publicly opened and read. The lowest responsive bidder must have completed, or under contract to complete, a Traffic Signal, Highway Lighting, Site Lighting, or LED Luminaire change out project to be considered for the award of this contract. All other bids may be rejected. This Project includes a wage determination developed by the State of Maine Department of Labor.

The work consists of replacing approximately 300 existing highway and site lighting luminaires with LED luminaires at Maine Turnpike entering and exiting ramps, toll plazas, service plazas, and toll barrier facilities. The work includes verifying existing luminaire and circuit voltages, furnishing and installing new conventional, mongoose, architectural and floodlight LED luminaires, including luminaire to pole adapters, furnishing and installing new pole wiring and pole breakaway splice kits, furnishing and installing new ground rods, if required, and all other work incidental thereto in accordance with the Plans and Specifications. Maintenance of traffic control devices and maintenance of traffic will be furnished by the Maine Turnpike Authority.

Contract Documents and appended Plans may be examined by prospective Bidders weekdays between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the office of the Maine Turnpike Authority, 2360 Congress Street, Portland, Maine. Electrical contractors and electrical suppliers may obtain copies of the Contract Documents, and appended Plans, from the Authority upon request. Bidders shall not contact any other Authority staff or Consultants for clarification of Contract provisions, and the Authority will not be responsible for any interpretations so obtained.

All work shall be governed by the Specifications entitled "State of Maine, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications, Revision of November 2014", "Standard Details, Revision of November 2014" and "Best Management Practices for Erosion and Sediment

Proposals must be accompanied by an original bid bond, certified or cashier's check payable to the Maine Turnpike Authority in an amount not less than Five (5%) Percent of the Total Amount in the Proposal, but not less than \$500.00. The Bidder to whom a Contract is awarded will be required to furnish a Surety Corporation Bond, satisfactory to the Authority, on the standard Contract Bond form of the Authority, for a sum not less than the Total Amount of the Proposal.

Proposals must be made upon the Proposal Forms furnished by the Authority separately with the Contract Documents, and must be enclosed in the sealed special addressed envelope provided therefore bearing the name and address of the Bidder, the name of the Contract, and the date and time of Proposal opening on the outside.

There will be no pre-bid conference for this project. All questions shall be submitted in writing, on or before 12:00pm (noon) on Wednesday, June 14, 2017 to Nate Carll, MTA Purchasing Manager at NCarll@maineturnpike.com. If necessary, an addendum will be issued on Friday, June 16, 2017.

The Authority reserves the unqualified right to reject any or all Proposals and to accept that Proposal which in its sole judgment will under all circumstances serve its best interest.
