Running Hill Road Bridge, South Portland



Project Highlights

- \$500,000 project part of \$3.4 million contract
- Awarded to Wyman & Simpson, Inc. from Richmond, ME
- Project anticipated to start the week of May 7th, 2018
- Replacement of bridge wearing surface
- Repairs to bridge joints, concrete deck and substructure
- Traffic reduced to one lane in each direction during construction
- Substantial completion date: June 15, 2018

The project includes bridge repairs to the Running Hill Road Bridge over the Maine Turnpike at Mile 45.4 in the City of South Portland. The repairs will include replacement of the bridge wearing surface, work on the bridge joints and repairs to the concrete deck and substructure.

During the repairs, the Running Hill Road Bridge will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction. The existing Average Annual Daily Traffic for the bridge is approximately 15,500.

The project is projected to be substantially complete by June 15, 2018.

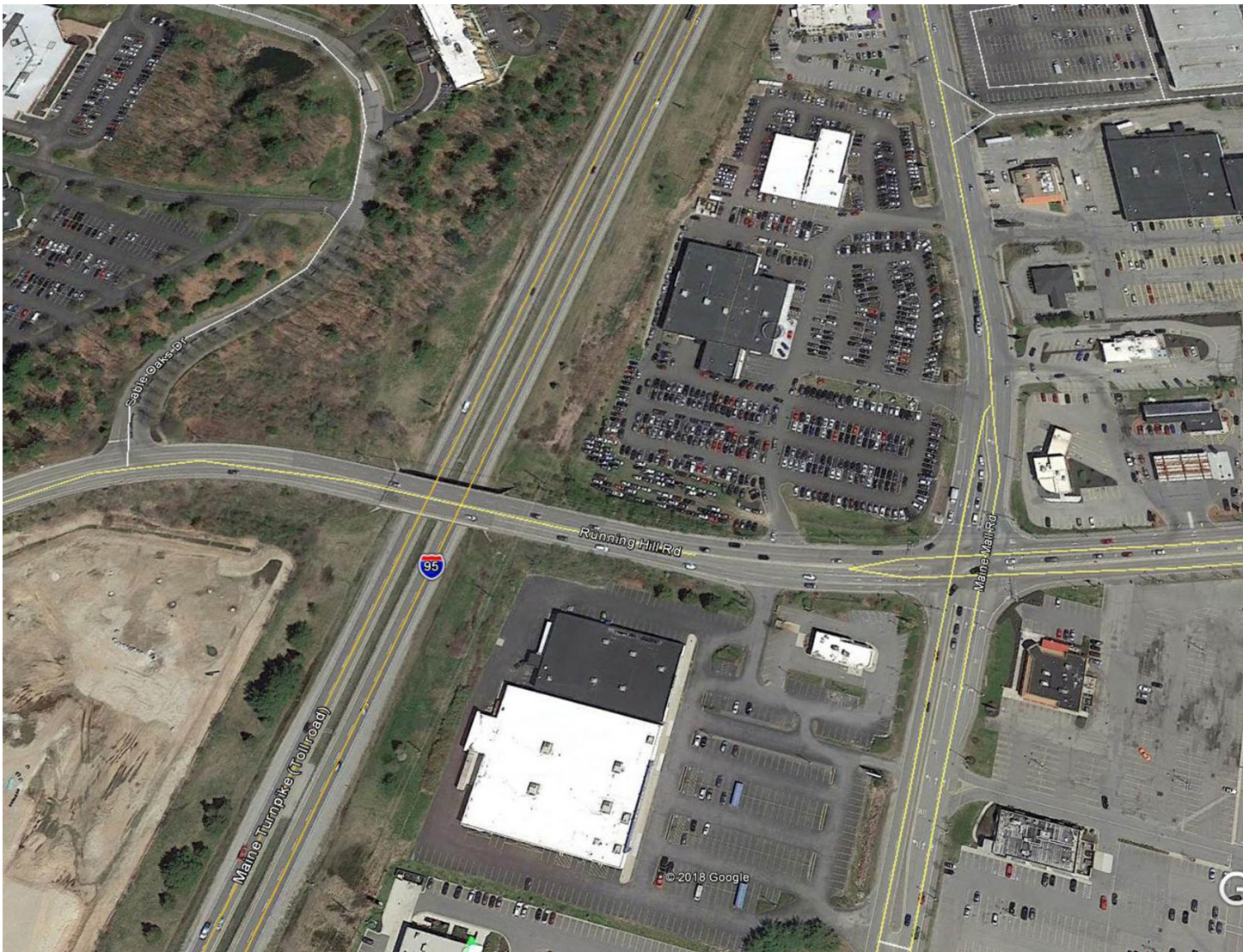
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Running Hill Road Bridge Project

Traffic Impacts During Construction



Existing Average Annual Daily Traffic (AADT) on the bridge is approximately 15,500. Once construction begins, traffic on Running Hill Road Bridge will be reduced to one lane in each direction for the duration of the project. The project is projected to be substantially complete by June 15, 2018.
