
2025 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Project Highlights

Maine Turnpike is making improvements to the Gray Road (Route 100/26) underpass in 2025

- This bridge is part of a contract for repairs to four bridges
- In total it is a \$2.5 million contract
- Repairs to the Gray Road Bridge will be approximately \$515,000
- Awarded to CPM Constructors, Inc., of Freeport, Maine
- Work is expected to start in early summer

The work consists of:

- New pavement on the bridge's surface
- Repairing bridge joints (this will help reduce the chance of plow damage to the joints)
- Repairing guardrail
- Adding a new protective coating over the existing structure, to slow down the deterioration of the concrete

This project consists of bridge joint modifications and header installations, adjacent pavement replacement, removing existing girder haunches, abutment patch repairs, and miscellaneous superstructure and substructure repairs.

The majority of this work will take place at night with single lane closures and alternating one way traffic.

Work is anticipated to start in early summer. All work is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2025

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
