## SCOPE OF WORK

The Authority may require surveying services for various projects related to the Maine Turnpike. Examples of project assignments may include, but are not limited to: baseline stakeout, leveling circuits, boundary surveys, Right-of-Way surveys, topographic surveys, cross-section surveys, wetland location surveys, GPS surveys, mapping verification surveys, existing condition surveys and construction layout surveys. The work to be performed on each specific project may include any or all of the above phases of work on various projects located throughout the Maine Turnpike System.

The surveying work must be performed in accordance with the requirements of the attached Maine Turnpike Authority Survey Guidelines. The required services will encompass a wide range of right of way, design and construction related surveying efforts. Consultants shall possess sufficient resources to be able to perform simultaneous survey projects upon short notice, and be able to meet tight completion schedules. The firms may be required to provide paper and electronic deliverables for topographic surveys, GIS data, survey worksheets, and GPS survey data in AutoCAD, DXF, ARC/INFO and Microstation formats.

Surveys must be completed under the direct supervision of a Maine registered Professional Land Surveyor.
