Cash Customers: Staffed booths available 24/7.

NO Pay-by-Plate: MTA will not send a bill. Pay-by-Plate is NOT available. Failure to pay results in a violation.

Class 1 Two-axle, four-tire vehicles - includes passenger cars, pickup trucks, vans and motorcycles



Class 2 Two-axle, six-tire vehicles - includes buses, motorhomes and dual-wheel pickups



Class 3 Three-axle vehicles and combinations – includes Class 2 vehicles towing one-axle trailers, and Buses



Class 4 Four-axle vehicles and combinations – includes Class 2 vehicles towing two-axle trailers



Class 5 Five-axle vehicles and combinations – minimum classification for vehicles requiring Over Limit Permit



Class 6 Six or more axle vehicles and combinations



Class 7 Class 1 vehicles, towing one-axle trailer – overall length limited to sixty (60) feet



Class 8 Class 1 vehicles, towing two-axle trailer – overall length limited to sixty (60) feet
