Project Highlights

MTA is making improvements to the St. Lawrence & Atlantic Railroad Overpass at mile 74.5 in Auburn

- This bridge is part of a contract for repairs to multiple bridges
- \$768,000 project - part of a \$2.5 million contract
- Awarded to CPM Constructors, Inc., of Freeport, Maine
- Work is expected to start in early spring

The work consists of:

- Concrete repairs
- Repairs to the bridge rail and joints
- Installing a high performance membrane
- Repaving

At the bridge over the St. Lawrence & Atlantic railroad the work includes high performance membrane removal and replacement, approach paving, repairs to impact damage on the bridge rail, bridge joint repairs and miscellaneous superstructure repairs.

There will be long term lane closures in both the northbound and southbound directions, but not simultaneously. Each closure will last for approximately 28 days. After April 14th NO WIDE LOADS over 10 feet will be allowed

Work is anticipated to start in mid-April and will last until mid-June.
